

ASSOCIATION OF CARAVAN CLUBS OF VICTORIA AND THEIR MEMBERS INC. -By Laws

These By Laws are supplemental to and should be read in conjunction with Consumer Affairs Victoria — Association Incorporation Reform Act 2012 — Model Rules for an Incorporated Association.

Date of acceptance by members — 26th May 2013.

MEMBERSHIP

Model Rules Part 3: Div 1: 8 replaced by —

By Law 1. Membership of the Association shall be available to all Incorporated Victorian Caravan Clubs approved by the Association.

Model Rules Part 3: Div 1: 14 replaced by

By Law 2. Associated membership of the Association shall be available to all Incorporated Caravan Clubs whose business address is outside the State of Victoria and approved by the Association.

Model Rules Part 3: Div 1: 16 (1) replaced by —

By Law 3. Ceasing Membership (1) A member of the Association having paid all monies due and payable by a member to the Association may resign from the Association by first giving one months' notice in writing to the Secretary of the member's intention to resign.

By Law 4. Delegate means a person appointed for the time being to represent the members of the Caravan Club at meetings of the Association. Each member caravan club may appoint two Delegates.

GENERAL MEETINGS OF THE ASSOCIATION

Model Rules Part 4: Div 38: (1) (a)—

By Law 5. Voting - Replace word "member" with word "delegate".

ATTENDANCE/REPRESENTATION OF MEMBER CLUBS AT MEETINGS

New by-law at AGM 23 October 2021:

It is recommended that clubs be represented at all three delegates meetings, including the AGM.

QUORUM AT MEETINGS

A quorum for delegates meetings is at least 2 of the main office bearers and at least 10 club delegates.

A quorum for executive committee meetings is at least 4 members, 2 of the main office bearers and 2 other committee members.
